## New Funds Serve Community



**Dr. Bernard J. Cigrand**

**The Dr. Bernard J. Cigrand Memorial Scholarship Fund** was created by a local Boy Scout, Galen Norman, with the proceeds of an Eagle Scout project he undertook to honor Dr. Cigrand. After consulting with Dr. Cigrand's granddaughter, Carol Cigrand Musaraca, terms were established for the administration of the fund. Upon reaching endowment status, the fund will provide scholarships to area students who are of Luxembourg descent or who were active in either the Boy Scouts or Girl Scouts. Dr. Cigrand (1866-1932) was a well known dentist who lived and practiced his profession in Chicago, Batavia and then Aurora. He also was a patriot. Throughout his dental career he campaigned tirelessly to have June 14th declared as a special day of observance to honor the United States flag. Finally in 1916, President Woodrow Wilson issued a proclamation that June 14th would become a national day to celebrate the birth of our flag. From that time, Dr. Cigrand became known as the "Father of Flag Day."



**The Hancock Family**

**The Josephine M. Hancock Endowment Fund** was created to administer an unrestricted bequest received from the estate of Josephine Hancock as a memorial to her family. Josephine Hancock (1902-2001) was born in Aurora and operated the Millinery Department of the Virginia Shop. She also was a volunteer at Hines Veteran's Hospital and was a member of the American Red Cross, Beta Sigma Phi Sorority and St. Rita of Cascia Church. Miss Hancock is pictured here (in the center) with her brother John Hancock and her sister Margaret Bennigsen. John Hancock, who passed away in 1994, was associated with the newspaper business. Mrs. Bennigsen, who passed away in 1996, was married to a Russian Count who immigrated to the United States during the Russian Revolution. Miss Hancock was also preceded in death by brother, Walter Hancock, and sister, Theresa Hancock.



**Carl & Anne Baumann**

**The Dr. Carl H.H. and Anne M. Baumann Endowment Fund** was established to administer bequests received from the estates of Carl and Anne Baumann. The fund will provide grants to Mutual Ground, Inc. of Aurora and for the Foundation's general grantmaking program. Carl Baumann (1921-2002) was born in Scranton, Pennsylvania. He received his medical degree from the University of Chicago and was a neurosurgeon in the Fox Valley area for most of his career. During World War II, he was a topographer for the United States Army in France and North Africa. He was a member of the Kane County Medical Society, Illinois Medical Society, American Medical Association and the American Association of Neurological Surgeons. Anne Baumann (1927-2002) was born in Aurora where she was a dedicated civic leader. She was an alderman for the City of Aurora, instructor at Waubensee Community College and field representative for the Neighborhood Reinvestment Corporation in Washington, D.C. She also produced and appeared weekly in Community Forum on Cable 12 TV. Mrs. Baumann served on the boards of directors of the League of Women Voters, United Way of the Aurora Area, Family Counseling Service and People for Child Care.



**Natalie Ann Brown**

**The Alicemae Brown Memorial Scholarship Endowment Fund In Memory of Natalie Ann Brown** was created upon receipt of a bequest from the estate of Alicemae Brown as a memorial to her granddaughter, Natalie Ann Brown. The fund will provide income for scholarships to local students. Alicemae Brown (1927-2001) of Aurora was married to Dr. Edwin C. Brown D.D.S. and assisted him in his practice for twenty years. Dr. Brown died in 1981. Their granddaughter, Natalie Ann Brown (1977-1994), was born in Tennessee. At the time of her passing, Natalie lived in Yorkville with her family. She had just completed her junior year at Yorkville High School where she was actively involved in basketball and poms. Natalie held several part-time jobs while modeling for Fine Image Photography and was a runner-up in the Glamour Models competition sponsored by the publication.



**Philip B. Foxgrover**

**The Philip Bennett Foxgrover Memorial Scholarship Endowment Fund** will provide annual scholarships to graduating high school seniors of Kaukauna Wisconsin High School who have excelled in high school music activities and who will continue such activities in college. Philip Foxgrover (1949-2001) was a 1967 graduate of Kaukauna High School where he participated in choral groups and musicals. He ministered to others for many years as a soloist at weddings and funerals. After graduation, he attended Carroll College in Waukesha, Wisconsin. He then began a career in mortgage banking at the Green Bay, Wisconsin branch of North Shore Bank of Milwaukee. Mr. Foxgrover was a conscientious employee who was highly regarded by those whom he supervised. He also dedicated himself to the care of his parents and other family members. Mr. Foxgrover's brother, Dr. David Foxgrover, is pastor of the Congregational Church of Batavia.



**Mary J. Boland**

**The Mary J. Boland Endowment Fund** is an unrestricted fund that will provide support to area non-profit organizations. The fund was created upon receipt of a bequest from the estate of Mary Boland. Miss Boland (1906-2002) was born in Fairfax, Iowa. She and her three sisters and brother were raised on a farm in Fairfax and often were the only students attending the local country school. She received her high school diploma from Mt. Mercy Academy in Cedar Rapids and her teaching certificate from Coe College in Cedar Rapids. Later, she earned a degree in music from Cedar Falls Teachers College. In 1931, Miss Boland moved to Aurora to begin a teaching career in the East Aurora Schools. She taught at Brady, Beaupre and Oak Park Schools. Later she was appointed supervisor of the music program at all eleven elementary schools. During her teaching career, she furthered her studies in music education at Columbia University in New York and she completed her graduate work at Northwestern University. Miss Boland retired in 1971 after nearly forty years of service to the East Aurora Schools. After retirement, she continued to contribute her talents in the area of music through volunteer work at schools and community events.

## FOUNDATION CENTER WILL CHALLENGE THINKING

In the spring of 2004, Aurora University and The Aurora Foundation will sponsor their first joint community symposium as a service to area citizens.

The annual symposiums, to be held at The Aurora Foundation Center for Community Enrichment, will address issues related to the areas of human service, education and business.

The Center, located on the campus of Aurora University, will be named in honor of the Foundation's recent commitment to the renovation of the Stephens Hall Complex.

A \$500,000 grant, payable over a five-year period, was awarded by the Foundation toward the project.

F James Garbe, a director of Aurora University and the Foundation, was the inspiration for the partnership.

"Our two organizations have enjoyed a rich and rewarding history of service to the Fox Valley Area. Through this new collaboration, we have resolved to strengthen the effectiveness of those services for years to come," said Garbe.

Sharon Stredde, president of the Foundation, noted that the symposiums will be designed to enrich lives and to challenge assumptions.

"We envision these sessions as energizing events to stir the thought processes and to encourage higher-order thinking," said Stredde.

Dr. Rebecca Sherrick, president of Aurora University, expressed appreciation for the Foundation grant and reaffirmed the University's role in sponsoring the symposiums.

She indicated that the annual events will draw together non-profit, civic, business and educational leaders to examine problems of common concern.

"Our objective will be to bring new ideas to the table for the purpose of allowing participants to reach their own conclusions."

**The Friends of Aurora's After-School Programs Fund** was created to provide support for after-school activities for elementary school children who attend the East or West Aurora Schools or who attend a private school located in the City of Aurora. Assistance is devoted to programs during non-academic hours and includes the purchase of books, teaching materials, incentives for meeting educational objectives and transportation. The need for programs to serve children after the school day continues to increase. This fund will help to support the efforts of dedicated volunteers who are committing their time and resources on behalf of Aurora's youth.

**The Phillips Park Zoociety Fund** supports improvements to the quality of the zoological exhibits found in the Phillips Park Zoo. The zoo was established in 1915 as an educational resource for citizens to view animals in a safe environment. Professional, humane care is provided for the animals housed at the zoo. Exhibits include an eagle, wolves, foxes, otters, sheep, birds, swans, reptiles and an elk herd. The zoo is open daily from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. until Labor Day.
