OUR WAY OF REMEMBERING



Dorothy Mae Bonner

The Dorothy Mae Bonner Memorial Scholarship Fund was created to honor the life of Dorothy Mae "Mother" Bonner. Mrs. Bonner (1921-2004) was born in Alexandria, Louisiana. She was a graduate of Wendell Phillips High School in Chicago where she was a member of the National Honor Society. In 1942, she married Bishop William Bonner who is currently the pastor of the Greater Mount Olive Church of God In Christ in Aurora. As the First Lady of her church and of the Sixth Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction of Illinois, Mrs. Bonner influenced the lives of others through her gift of an understanding heart. According to friends, Mrs. Bonner was known as Mother Bonner for her skills as a master caregiver to those with whom she came into contact. She assumed a quiet profile in life, preferring to encourage the success of others. Her many acts of kindness will now be publicly recognized through the awarding of scholarships in her name. Mrs. Bonner is survived by her husband and her three children, Enyess Allen, Willie Etta Wright and Dorothy Jones. She was preceded in death by her son, Charles.



Wilfred A. Kramer

The Wilfred A. Kramer Endowment Fund was created to provide income for the general grantmaking purposes of the Foundation. Wilfred Kramer (1922-2004) attended St. Nicholas Grade School in Aurora and was a graduate of Marmion Military Academy. After high school, he was a student at Niagara and Marquette Universities and played on the football teams of both schools. Mr. Kramer was a veteran of the United States Navy and served as a pilot during World War II. He flew dozens of bombing missions in the South Pacific that eventually led to his presence aboard the USS Missouri when the Japanese officially surrendered to the Allies. Mr. Kramer played on the Navy football team. In 1943, he was selected to the College All Star Game. After the war, he played professionally for the Cleveland Browns and the Buffalo Bills and later became a member of the NFL Alumni Association. In 1947, Mr. Kramer founded Janco Supply in Aurora and served as the company's chief executive officer. He is survived by his wife, Marian, and his three sons William, James and Daniel.



Marjory J. Nelson

The Marjory J. Nelson Memorial Fund was established to provide grants to the East Aurora School District for its health education program. Marjory Nelson (1928-1998) received her Bachelor of Arts Degree from Aurora University and her R.N. certification from the Copley Hospital School of Nursing. She also undertook additional graduate studies at Northern Illinois University and the National College of Education. She was employed by Copley Memorial Hospital and later served as a nurse for the East Aurora Schools. This fund was created by Mrs. Nelson's family to provide recognition of her dedication to the students of the East Aurora Schools. According to her husband Robert, Mrs. Nelson and her colleagues were always seeking ways to provide extra services to students that were beyond the scope of the traditional district budget. "Through the creation of this fund, we are honoring all nurses of the East Aurora Schools who have given their time and personal resources to serve the needs of children." Marj Nelson is survived by her husband and two daughters, Judith Bianchetta and Dr. Karen Nelson. Mrs. Bianchetta and her daughter, Lisa Hatchel, are teachers in the East Aurora School District. Dr. Nelson is a physician in Tacoma, Washington.



Daniel W. Schindlbeck

The Daniel W. Schindlbeck Memorial Scholarship Fund was created by his colleagues and friends to pay tribute to one of the most respected law enforcement officers in Kane County. Daniel Schindlbeck (1943-2004) was a graduate of Marmion Military Academy. In 1976, he received a Master Degree in Criminal Justice from Michigan State University. He was a police officer in Aurora for twenty-eight years, reaching the rank of Lieutenant before retiring in 1994. He then joined the Kane County Sheriff's Office for ten years and was serving as Undersheriff at the time of his passing. Mr. Schindlbeck was past president of the Kane County Chiefs of Police, member of the Illinois Chiefs of Police, Illinois Sheriff Association, Fraternal Order of Police Lodge #14, the Illinois Police Association, Aurora Turners Club and the Batavia Moose Lodge #682. Mr. Schindlbeck is survived by his wife, Janice, and three children, Steven Schindlbeck, Christine Fitzgerald and Stacey Vaja. The scholarship in his memory will provide assistance to local students pursuing a career in criminal justice or law enforcement.



Ellen & Robert Weber

The Ellen L. and Robert L. Weber Scholarship Fund was established by their daughter, Stephanie, as a tribute to her parents. Robert Weber (1914-1977) was born and raised in Chicago. In the early 1940's, he and his wife, Ellen, moved to Aurora. Mr. Weber was a branch manager for the American News Company. He served in the United States Army during World War II and was stationed in Europe. Ellen Weber (1918-1979) was also born and raised in Chicago. She was a homemaker while her children were young. Mrs. Weber was active in the Aurora Woman's Club and the East Aurora School PTA's. Later, she was employed at the Aurora Public Library's Bardwell Branch and continued as Learning Center Director when the branch became a part of the public schools. Mr. and Mrs. Weber were staunch supporters of Aurora and the East Aurora School System. Their two children, Stephanie and Barbara, were graduates of East Aurora High School. The scholarship fund is reserved for students who have survived the loss of a family member or friend to suicide. Preference will be given to students graduating from East Aurora High School.



Morris & Sarah Weisman

The Morris and Sarah Weisman Memorial Endowment Fund was created upon receipt of an unrestricted bequest from the estate of their only child, Sol Weisman. Morris and Sarah Weisman were born in Russia and immigrated to the United States shortly before World War I. They later met in Omaha where each had settled. Morris Weisman (1895-1977) moved to Aurora in 1917 and the couple was married the following year in Aurora. Mr. Weisman was a partner in the Aurora Window Cleaning Company for fifty-one years until the business was sold in 1968. He was past president and treasurer of Temple B'nai Israel. He also was a member of the Aurora B'nai B'rith Lodge, the American Legion Roosevelt Aurora Post 84 and the Loyal Order of the Moose Lodge #400. Sarah Weisman (1897-1983) was a member of Temple B'nai Israel and the Temple's Sisterhood. She also was a lifetime member of Hadassah and the National Council of Jewish Women. Sol Weisman (1918-2003) was born in Aurora. He was a graduate of the University of Chicago and lived most of his life in Chicago. Sol Weisman was self-employed.

Her bequest reflects her devotion and gratitude to the church that had meant so much to her life.

A bequest from the estate of Irene M. Raymond (1909-1984) provides for the general grantmaking purposes of the Foundation. Mrs. Raymond was a resident of Aurora and a homemaker. Her husband, Roy D. Raymond (1908-1980), was the owner of the Lakone Company in Montgomery and a member of the Kane County Board of Appeals.



Louise G. Lane

A bequest from the estate of Louise G. Lane was placed in three existing Foundation funds: The Aurora Foundation Permanent Endowment Fund, Louise G. and Margaret E. Lane Scholarship Endowment Fund and New England Congregational Church Designated Endowment Fund. Louise Lane (1907-2003) was a teacher in the West Aurora School System for many years.



Marian G. Stare

A bequest from the estate of Marian Goodwin Stare was placed in the Paul Francis and Marian Goodwin Stare Endowment Fund. The fund provides annual grants to Holy Angels Catholic Church in Aurora. Marian Stare (1908-2003) and her husband, Paul (1906-2000), were active members of Holy Angels Church. An earlier bequest from Mr. Stare's estate established the couple's endowment fund.



David B. Perry

A bequest from the estate of David B. Perry (1919-2003) was designated for the establishment of the David B. Perry Endowment Fund. Through his bequest, Mr. Perry provided for the perpetual support of several Kaneville institutions: the Public Library, Historical Society, Community Child Center, Volunteer Fire Department and Community Center.



Morris & Sarah Weisman

Sol Weisman provided an unrestricted bequest to the Foundation for the establishment of an endowment fund as a memorial to his parents, Morris Weisman (1895-1977) and Sarah Weisman (1897-1983). The Weismans were active members of the Aurora community for many years. Sol Weisman (1918-2003) was self-employed and lived in Chicago at the time of his death.
