## HONORING LOVED ONES AND FRIENDS



**Brian A. Harty**

**The Brian A. Harty Memorial Advisory Endowment Fund** was established from the proceeds of the estate of Brian Alexander Harty by his parents and sister to honor his memory. Brian Harty (1975-2002) was a 1997 graduate of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. He had worked in radio production for stations in Chicago and Raleigh. He was an avid runner, twice completing the Chicago Marathon. He also was an amateur oil painter and a fan of many different genres of music. This fund will support research and education in the areas of depression and suicide prevention.



**W. Charlie & Shirley L. Hooper**

**The W. Charlie Hooper and Shirley Linder Hooper Scholarship Endowment Fund** was created upon receipt of a bequest from the estates of Mr. and Mrs. Hooper. W. Charlie Hooper (1909-1995) was born in Hillsboro, Texas. He was an accountant with Podolak, Hooper and Kerr in Aurora. Mr. Hooper also was a charter member of the Aurora Optimist Club and a member of the B.P.O. Elks Lodge of Aurora and New England Congregational Church. Shirley Hooper (1911-2003) was born in Grand Junction, Colorado. She also was a member of New England Congregational Church. During the last years of the couple's life, they resided in Venice, Florida.



**Donie & Marie Marzuki**

**The Donie, Marie and Judy Marzuki Endowment Fund** was established by the children of Donie and Marie Marzuki to recognize and honor their parents for their devotion and sacrifice in raising a family during difficult economic times. Like many other people, Mr. and Mrs. Marzuki were first generation Americans who achieved a successful and fulfilling life in the face of adversity, including the loss of a child to fire. Donie Marzuki (1895-1976) was employed as a milkman and Marie Marzuki (1901-1976) was a homemaker. Their daughter, Judy, is also honored by this fund. In spite of profound disabilities, Judy Marzuki (1943-2000) overcame great obstacles to bring much joy and happiness to her family and friends. This fund provides grants to Keeler Center of Aurora to encourage outdoor activities for their disabled clients.

**The Judy Marzuki Endowment Fund for Wildlife** was created in loving memory of Judy Marzuki by her sister and brothers. Profoundly disabled, Judy Marzuki (1943-2000) found that nature and wildlife do not distinguish between handicapped and non-handicapped people. Together, she and her caregivers found much enjoyment and beauty when visiting nature and observing wildlife. Wildlife teaches valuable lessons on the struggles of life. It teaches that these struggles can be relieved through the efforts of those who share their time and talent. The purpose of this fund is to encourage individuals to participate in volunteer activities at area wildlife centers.



**David B. Perry**

**The David B. Perry Endowment Fund** was established to administer a bequest from the estate of David B. Perry. Mr. Perry (1919-2003) was born in Kaneville Township. His great grandfather, Amos Miner, was the first settler in the township. Mr. Perry lived most of his life in the home that his great grandfather built. As a devoted member of the Kaneville Historical Society, Mr. Perry worked tirelessly to preserve the rich heritage of his community. For a number of years, he was employed by Northern Illinois University. He also raised cattle as well as crops on the land that he loved. He and his wife, Marian, were faithful attendees of the Chicago Opera and shared a deep respect for the traditions of the Kaneville community. Mrs. Perry died in 1989. This fund shall provide income for the support of charitable organizations located in Kaneville.



**Brenda J. Price**

**The Brenda J. Price Memorial Fund** was created to honor the life of Brenda J. Price. Brenda Price (1966-2003) was born in Rockford, Illinois. She was a graduate of West Aurora High School where she was a member of the badminton team. She received a Bachelor of Arts and a Master of Arts degree in educational psychology from Eastern Illinois University. Brenda worked for several years in the field of social work in Kansas. She especially enjoyed her work with senior citizens. She also was a devoted foster parent for five years. This fund will provide scholarships to graduates of West Aurora High School who are attending Eastern Illinois University.

Dr. Sherry Eagle, superintendent of the school district, was the inspiration for the new foundation. Over sixty citizens from Aurora, North Aurora and Montgomery are members of the organization. Reading with a child helps

to develop skills that are critical to future academic success. Reading "to" a child creates a sense of wonder. Reading "with" a child creates a sense of well-being that will remain forever in that child's memory. Ormond is a graduate of West Aurora High School. He received a BS degree in engineering from Yale University and a MBA in marketing and personnel from the Stanford University Graduate School of Business.

Mr. Ormond retired from W.W. Grainger, Inc. of Skokie in 1995 where he served as a corporate officer and vice president of human resources.

Foremost among Ormond's current civic roles is his forty-year career as a radio and television sportscaster for college and high school teams, most notably the West Aurora Blackhawks. He also has served as a manager and coach of many youth athletic teams in Aurora.

Neal Ormond III was elected to The Aurora Foundation's governing board at the organization's recent annual meeting.

Mr. Ormond has been a member of the Board of Education for School District 129 since 1996 and currently serves as vice president. He co-founded and has been on the board of the Blackhawk Sports Boosters Club since 1970 and has volunteered as assistant varsity coach for several sports at West Aurora High School since 1995.

Recognitions include the Illinois Basketball Coaches Hall of Fame, Illinois Athletic Directors Association - Friend of Athletics Award, West Aurora Sports Hall of Fame, Optimist Club Citizen of the Year and West Aurora Homecoming Parade Grand Marshal. 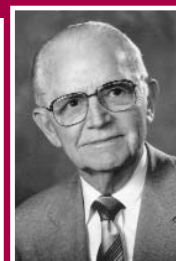
