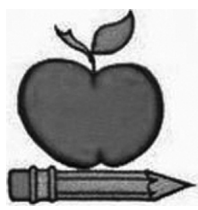

NEW CHARITABLE FUNDS CREATED



Barbara & Gerald Morrow

The **Gerald and Barbara Morrow Family Endowment Fund** provides income for the unrestricted purposes of the Foundation. Barbara (Biever) Morrow was born in Aurora. Her family heritage of civic service in Aurora, through the Biever Furniture Company, dates back to the company's founding in 1881. Following her graduation from Northwestern University, she had a gratifying career as a third grade teacher at Freeman Elementary School. She was recognized for her achievements by West Aurora School District 129 with the "Golden Apple Award." Gerald Morrow, a CPA and graduate of the University of Illinois, was treasurer of the City of Aurora for eight years. He was honored by election as president of the Illinois Municipal Finance Officers and as chairman of an Illinois CPA Society committee charged with rewriting the State of Illinois' municipal accounting standards. Mr. Morrow then served as treasurer of the Wadsworth Golf Construction Company for over thirty-five years. He later was elected to a four-year term as auditor for Kane County. He also was an instructor for evening advanced accounting classes at Aurora University, president of the Aurora Kiwanis Club and an active participant in United Way. During World War II, Mr. Morrow served his country as an Army Paratroop demolition specialist with the First Allied Airborne in Europe.



AARTA

The **Aurora Area Retired Teachers' Association (AARTA)** has been working for retired teachers in Kane County for over fifty years. Due to their continued interest in education, members of the AARTA created the Aurora Area Retired Teachers' Association Scholarship Fund to assist students attending a two-year college, or a professional, trade or vocational school. Eligibility is restricted to students who reside within the Community Foundation service area and within the boundaries of the following school districts: East Aurora 131, West Aurora 129, Kaneland 302, Batavia 101, Geneva 304 or St. Charles 303. The AARTA, which is the local unit of the Illinois Retired Teachers' Association, has over 400 members. In addition to providing this scholarship, members create and distribute lap blankets to residents of area care centers.



Tanner House Museum

The **Aurora Historical Society 21st Century Museum Fund** underwrites innovative projects that will make history increasingly relevant for current and former members of the Aurora community. Grants from the fund will help the Society expand the effectiveness of its website with the goal of bringing the museum into the homes of all citizens. Other grants will enable the organization to upgrade its exhibits and programs for on-site visitors. Since its founding in 1906, the Society has collected many thousands of artifacts including pre-historic mastodon bones, tools, toys, clothing and textiles, clocks and watches, Native American Indian artifacts, and a variety of other materials with local connections. Many of the items are Aurora-made products, such as the rare, restored 1910 Thor Motorcycle. The Society operates two Aurora museum sites—the William Tanner House Museum, located at the corner of Oak & Cedar, and the David L. Pierce Art & History Center at 20 East Downer Place. For over one hundred years, the Society has been the valued caretaker of Aurora's rich local heritage.



Genevieve & Edward Jungels

The **Edward and Genevieve Jungels Scholarship Fund** was established to provide scholarships to students pursuing studies within the field of veterinary medicine. Edward Jungels was born and raised in Aurora. He attended Sacred Heart Grade School, St. Nicholas School, and is a graduate of East Aurora High School. For twenty-nine years, he worked at AllSteel in the tool room and was a member of the AllSteel Quarter Century Club. Genevieve Jungels was also born and raised in Aurora. She attended Nicholson Elementary School and West Aurora High School. She was employed by Pictorial Package in Aurora for ten years as a proof-reader. In 1966, Mr. and Mrs. Jungels moved to their current residence in Montgomery, Illinois. Edward and Genevieve Jungels enjoyed many years of caring for several canine friends. It is in this spirit that they chose to establish a fund to provide support to future veterinarians.



Shirley Miller Hurd

The **Shirley M. Hurd Education Scholarship Fund** was created upon receipt of a bequest from the estate of Shirley Miller Hurd. The fund supports college scholarships for local students. In the awarding of these scholarships, preference is given to students attending Northwestern University. Shirley Miller Hurd (1922-2010) was born in Aurora, Illinois. She was a graduate of Holy Angels School and Madonna High School. At the age of seventeen, she began working at Stephens-Adamson Company where she remained for thirty-one years. Mrs. Hurd met her future husband, Charles B. Hurd, at the company. They were married in 1970. Mr. Hurd organized and was president of the world famous Sealmaster Softball team. He and his wife traveled throughout the country with the team, which eventually achieved championship status. Mrs. Hurd was a member of St. Peter Catholic Church, where she established a scholarship for students attending St. Peter Catholic School.



William Sweeney

The **Bill Sweeney Memorial Scholarship Fund** was created by the family and friends of William M. Sweeney to honor the life of this extraordinary Aurora educator. The fund provides scholarships to outstanding graduates of West Aurora High School pursuing a career in math education. Mr. Sweeney (1943-2010) was born in Bloomington, Illinois and was a graduate of Trinity High School in Bloomington. An avid sports enthusiast, he played basketball, football, and baseball during high school. In addition, he earned a Bachelor of Science in Education from Illinois State University and a Master of Science in Education from Northern Illinois University. Mr. Sweeney taught mathematics and was a guidance counselor for West Aurora School District 129 for thirty-four years. He coached basketball and football at Franklin Middle School, and later coached varsity football at West Aurora as an offensive coordinator. He also worked at the Fox Valley Park District for over twenty years, the majority of which was spent as Athletic Director. After retiring from education, Mr. Sweeney worked for nine years at AXA-Equitable, where he was a financial planner for teachers.

Chief Blackhawk has been the mascot of West High since 1936. Future projects will be determined by the Class of 1958 in consultation with school administrators.
