NEW FUNDS SERVE COMMUNITY



Steven J. Duranceau

The Steven John Duranceau Memorial Scholarship Fund was created to honor the life of Steven Duranceau. The fund awards scholarships to residents of the Community Foundation's service area who are or have been actively involved in the Girl Scouts or Boy Scouts. Steven Duranceau (1955-2006) was a graduate of St. Rita of Cascia School and West Aurora High School. He received a Bachelor of Science degree in business at Illinois State University. He was employed at MetLife as a customer relations account manager. When MetLife merged with United Healthcare in 1996, he assumed a position as account executive at the new firm. While attending St. Rita of Cascia School, Mr. Duranceau was active in Boy Scout Troop 53 and earned the rank of Eagle Scout from the Boy Scouts of America. He later became scout master for a troop in Aurora. An avid runner, Mr. Duranceau completed twelve marathons — eight in Chicago, one in Milwaukee, one in Phoenix and two in Orlando. He was survived by his wife, Cynthia, and son, Andrew.



Gerald E. Hart, Jr.

The Jerry Hart Memorial Scholarship Fund was established in honor of educator Gerald E. Hart, Jr. to provide scholarships to graduating seniors from East Aurora High School who had previously been enrolled at Waldo Middle School. To be eligible for these scholarships, students must be pursuing a science-related course of study. Jerry Hart (1943-1994) was born in Aurora, Illinois. He was a graduate of Aurora University and earned a Masters Degree from Northern Illinois University. Mr. Hart was a member of First Presbyterian Church where he served as an elder. He also was a member of the American Federation of Teachers. Mr. Hart was a dedicated and well-respected science teacher at Waldo Middle School. At the time of his death, a scholarship fund was created within the East Aurora Schools to honor his commitment to the students at Waldo Middle School. The fund now is administered by the Community Foundation.



Edward E. Doebert

The Doebert Family Scholarship Fund in Memory of Edward E. Doebert was created by the Doebert Family to honor the memory of Edward E. Doebert (1956-2009). Mr. Doebert graduated from East Aurora High School in 1974 where he was active in band and was the editor of the yearbook. He was a teacher for Hinsdale School District 181 for twenty-seven years. While working at the elementary level, he was the educator for gifted students. When Mr. Doebert moved to the middle school level, he redesigned the 8th grade science curriculum to reflect best practices in education. His parents, Eugene and Dolores Doebert, are life-long residents of Aurora and have been active in their community. Eugene Doebert graduated from East Aurora High School and was a member of the Aurora Council of Clubs and served as the Third Ward Alderman. Mrs. Doebert graduated from West Aurora High School and was active in PTA and Girl Scouts. The Doebert Family wishes to honor Edward Doebert's love of teaching by assisting an East Aurora High School graduate who plans to attend a four year college/university and major in education.



Shirley & Donald Hartlaub

The Don and Shirley Hartlaub Memorial Endowment Fund was created by the children of Donald G. & Shirley W. Hartlaub to honor the lives of their parents. Annual grants are awarded from the fund to Aurora Central Catholic High School. Donald Hartlaub, Sr. (1921-2009) was born in Cincinnati, Ohio. He was raised in Chicago and was a graduate of St. Patrick High School. Mr. Hartlaub earned the rank of lieutenant while serving in the United States Navy and was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross and Air Medal. For 35 years, Mr. Hartlaub owned and operated Don's Service Station & U-Haul at the corner of Illinois and Broadway in Aurora. Shirley Hartlaub (1928-2009) was born in Wheaton, Illinois, and moved to Aurora early in her life. She was a graduate of East Aurora High School and the Oak Park School of Nursing. She worked at Oak Park Hospital and for Dr. H.M. DeBartolo, Sr. in Aurora. Mr. and Mrs. Hartlaub volunteered for many charitable organizations and were members of Annunciation Church of Aurora for over fifty years. They will be remembered for their strong support of Catholic education. It is in this spirit that this fund has been established.



Shirley & Warren Eggers

The Warren J. and Shirley J. Eggers Scholarship Fund was created to honor the life of Warren Eggers, who passed away on February 15, 2010. The fund provides scholarships to local students with great financial need who wish to further their education upon graduation from high school. Warren Eggers (1935-2010) was born in Chicago, Illinois and grew up in River Forest, Illinois. He was a graduate of Oak Park-River Forest High School and Elmhurst College. Upon graduation from college, he was employed as a research chemist at the Sherwin-Williams Company. In 1966, the family moved to the Aurora area where Mr. Eggers continued his work in the paint and adhesive industry. He and a group of colleagues purchased the former River Valley Coatings. He retired from the company in 1996. Warren Eggers was an active member of Bethany Lutheran Church in Batavia. He served as a director of the Waubensee Community College Foundation, chairman of the Valley Industrial Association, member of the Kane County Bar Foundation and member of the Community Foundation Scholarship Committee. Mr. Eggers and his wife, Shirley, had five children.



Arnold & Donna Lies

The Arnold E. and Donna Lies Family Endowment Fund was established to provide support for the charitable needs of the Aurora community. Arnold Lies is a life-long resident of Aurora. He attended St. Therese Grade School, Marmion Academy and Marquette University. Mr. Lies was a second lieutenant in the United States Army during the Korean War. He was stationed at Fort Benning, Georgia and Camp Cooke in California. For over fifty years, he has owned and operated the Arnold Lies Company, a contracting firm responsible for the construction of many notable buildings in the Aurora area. He has given back to his community through his service to Holy Angels Church, Provena Mercy Medical Center, Aurora Exchange Club and the West Aurora High School Sports Boosters Club. Donna Lies is a graduate of Holy Angels Grade School and West Aurora High School. She has volunteered for Provena Mercy Medical Center and St. Anne's Society of Holy Angels Church. According to Mr. and Mrs. Lies, "We have created an endowment fund within the Community Foundation to provide an ongoing legacy for the benefit of the community in which we have lived and raised our family."

AURORA HERO REMEMBERED

The Lance Corporal Hector Ramos Memorial Scholarship Fund was created to honor the life of Hector Ramos. The fund provides scholarships to graduates of East Aurora High School who have demonstrated respect for the educational process throughout their high school years and a resolve to be successful in their pursuit of a higher education. In the awarding of these scholarships, preference is given to those students who were involved in the fine arts curriculum at East Aurora High School. Hector Ramos (1984-2005) was born in Aurora, Illinois. He was a 2003 graduate of East Aurora High School. He achieved

the rank of lance corporal in the United States Marine Corps. He died on January 26, 2005 while supporting Operation Iraqi Freedom when his helicopter crashed in a desert sandstorm near the town of Rutbah, Iraq. Hector Ramos excelled in the fine arts and drama at high school. He planned to pursue a career as an artist upon his return from the service. Friends and teachers at East Aurora High School described him as smiling, friendly, outgoing, creative, talented, involved, fun-loving and proud. One of the school's advisors characterized him as a born leader. "Some kids just stand out. Hector was one of those students."

We are sad to announce the passing of Warren F. Cannon (1927-2010), who was a director of the Community Foundation for ten years. Mr. Cannon was a lifelong Auroran and a graduate of East Aurora High School. In 1999, he retired as senior personnel administrator at Fermi National Accelerator Laboratory in Batavia. In addition to serving as a director of the Community Foundation, he also served on the Aurora Housing Authority Board and the Board of Education of West Aurora School District 129. Mr. Cannon was a member of Main Street Baptist Church.
